

I hope everyone is enjoying the beautiful fall weather we have been having. It has certainly been great football weather and great to see the Patriots cruise on


to 7-0! We are coming off our educational seminar, which was a great success and would like to thank Bob Lockhead for the excellent presentation he gave on emulsions and thickeners.






